USDA FOREST SERVICE UINTA NATIONAL FOREST HEBER RANGER DISTRICT WASATCH COUNTY, UTAH

Proposed Hoy Hollow Corral

The proposed action is to construct a cattle corral approximately 100 yards north of the Forest Service Boundary just off the Hoy Hollow road located approximately 25 air miles east of Heber City, Utah. (SW 1/4, SW1/4 of Section 20, T 1 N, R 9 W, USM). The corral will be constructed out of post and pole with some metal panels. The corral will have a diameter of about 200 feet. This proposed action is to help facilitate trucking of cattle in the spring instead of trailing and provide a place for doctoring livestock. The nearest working cattle corral is on the Forest Boundary in the upper reach of Lake Creek approximately 10 miles to the west. Construction is proposed for the summer of 2005.
