

PUBLIC COMMENT ON PROPOSED ACTION

Snowbird Ski Trail Improvement
USDA Forest Service – Uinta National Forest
Utah County, Utah

The Pleasant Grove Ranger District, Uinta National Forest, has received a proposal from Snowbird Ski and Summer Resort to realign a segment of the Path to Paradise ski trail to address safety concerns associated with the steep grade leading to the ski slope. The existing ski trail is located on private land and provides access to ski terrain on private land in Mineral Basin.

The Proposed Action would realign the ski trail to a 10 percent grade and would install a winch anchor at the end of the trail to facilitate grooming operations. The last 330 feet of the trail and the winch anchor would be on National Forest System land. The project area is located in Utah County, Section 17, Township 2 South, Range 2 East, Salt Lake Meridian.
