

**NOTICE OF DECISION
USDA - FOREST SERVICE
UINTA NATIONAL FOREST
HOY HOLLOW CORRAL**

The Heber Ranger District of the Uinta National Forest has completed an analysis to construct the Hoy Hollow Corral. The project is located within the West Fork of the Duchesne River watershed approximately 25 miles east of Heber, Utah. The purpose is to provide a livestock handling facility for the West Fork cattle allotment and reduce the need for trailing cattle to the allotment.

The Responsible Official, Heber District Ranger Julie King, approved a Decision Memo for this project on May 24, 2005. The project is scheduled for implementation and completion in summer of 2005. Pursuant to 36 CFR 215.12 (f), this decision is not subject to a higher level of review or appeal. Implementation may begin immediately.
