

PUBLIC COMMENT ON PROPOSED ACTION

Homestead Snowmobiling Five-Year Permit
USDA Forest Service – Uinta National Forest
Utah County, Utah

The Pleasant Grove Ranger District, Uinta National Forest, is initiating scoping and requesting public comment on a proposal to issue a five-year outfitter and guide special use permit to Homestead Snowmobiling to conduct guided snowmobile tours.

The guided tours would begin from the base of Mineral Basin chairlift on Snowbird Ski Resort land and Wasatch Mountain State Park Clubhouse. Guided tours would be conducted between the middle of November and the end of March. Maintenance and refueling of snowmobiles would be done off the national forest.

The legal description for the proposed special use permitted area is as follows: T3S, R3E Sections 17, 16, 22, 27, 28, 33, 32, 12, 13, 14, 24, 25, and 26; T4S, R3E Sections 5, 8, 7, and 6; T4S, R2E Section 1; T5S, R3E Sections 3, 4, 33, 28, 21, 22, 23, and 24
