

NOTICE OF DECISION
Homestead Snowmobiling Permit

USDA-Forest Service
Uinta National Forest
Pleasant Grove Ranger District
Utah and Wasatch Counties, Utah

The Uinta National Forest has completed an environmental analysis to issue a five-year special use permit to Homestead Snowmobiling for guided snowmobile tours on portions of the Pleasant Grove Ranger District from the middle of November to the end of March annually.

The project area is on groomed snowmobile trails or snow-play areas designated as open for over-snow vehicles in the following areas:

- T3S, R3E Sections 17, 16, 22, 27, 28, 33, 32, 12, 13, 14, 24, 25, and 26
- T4S, R3E Sections 5, 8, 7, and 6
- T4S, R2E Section 1
- T5S, R3E Sections 3, 4, 33, 28, 21, 22, 23, and 24

The Responsible Official, Pleasant Grove District Ranger Pamela Gardner, approved a Decision Memo for this project on November 18, 2005. This legal notice provides notification of the final decision associated with the project. Pursuant to 36 CFR 2155.12(f) and *Earth Island Institute v. Ruthenbeck*, No. CIV F-03-386 JKS (E.D. Cal., October 19, 2005), this decision is not subject to appeal.
