

NOTICE OF DECISION  
**Aspen Grove Fuel and Insect Treatment**

**USDA Forest Service  
Uinta National Forest  
Pleasant Grove Ranger District  
Utah County, Utah**

The Uinta National Forest has completed an environmental analysis for a proposed fuel and insect treatment in the Aspen Grove area of the Pleasant Grove Ranger District. The project area is located about two miles northwest of the Sundance Resort along the Alpine Loop Scenic Backway (State Route 92), in T. 5S., R. 3E., Sections 4 & 9, Salt Lake Base Meridian.

The Responsible Official, Pleasant Grove District Ranger Pamela J. Gardner, approved a Decision Memo for this project on April 24, 2006. Her decision is to implement the placement of pheromones and funnel traps to reduce and monitor beetle populations within the affected area. The piling and burning of affected down Douglas-fir trees was not approved as part of this project.

This legal notice provides notification of the final decision associated with the project. Pursuant to 36 CFR 2155.12(f) and *Earth Island Institute v. Ruthenbeck*, No. CIV F-03-386 JKS (E.D. Cal., October 19, 2005), this decision is not subject to appeal.
