

PUBLIC COMMENT ON PROPOSED ACTION
Little Mill Campground Bridge Construction Project
USDA Forest Service – Uinta National Forest
Utah County, Utah

The Pleasant Grove Ranger District, Uinta National Forest, is proposing to install a new two-lane vehicle bridge across the American Fork River to connect the North Mill campground to the Little Mill campground. This bridge would be part of reconstruction plans for the Little Mill and North Mill campgrounds. North Mill and Little Mill campgrounds are located in the SE ¼ Section 24, SW ¼ Section 24, NW ¼ Section 25, NE ¼ Section 26 of Township 4 South, Range 2 East, Salt Lake Meridian.

The Proposed Action would install a new bridge from North Mill campground to Little Mill campground. The bridge would join the two campgrounds and result in a combined campground. The new bridge would be a precast-prestressed concrete superstructure with constructed cast-in-place concrete footings, abutments, and wingwalls. The bridge width would be two lane and would accommodate pedestrian traffic. The bridge span would accommodate peak flows and abutments would be positioned out of natural stream course. The bridge surface and approaches would be hot bituminous plantmix.

The public is invited to comment on the proposed action. Only those who submit timely and substantive comments will be accepted as appellants. Substantive comments are those within the scope of, are specific to, and have a direct relationship to the proposed action, and include supporting reasons that the Responsible Official should consider in reaching a decision.

Each individual or representative from each organization submitting substantive comments must either sign the comments or otherwise verify identity in order to attain appeal eligibility. Comments received in response to this solicitation, including names and addresses of those who comment, will be considered part of the public record for this project. Comments should include the information required pursuant to 36 CFR 215.6(a)(3), as published in the Federal Register on June 4, 2003.
