**Moon Lake Electric Special Use Permit Re-issuance**

The Responsible Official, Uinta National Forest Supervisor Brian Ferebee, has approved re-issuance of special use permits #HBR402002, #HBR402001, and #HBR4020 into one authorization for an existing power transmission system and electrical substation. The power transmission system is located in three locations, Strawberry Valley, Currant Creek, and Hoy Hollow. The permit covers approximately 99.8 acres or approximately 36 miles and is issued to the Moon Lake Electric for the purpose of operating and maintaining a power transmission system and electrical substation. There are no changes to the authorized facilities or increases in the scope or intensity of the authorized activities.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 215.12(f) and *Earth Island Institute v. Ruthenbeck*, No. CIV F-03-386 JKS (E.D. Cal., October 19, 2005), this decision is not subject to appeal. Implementation may begin immediately.
