The Spanish Fork District Ranger is proposing to reissue a special use permit authorizing the permit holder to continue use and maintenance of the Juab County gravel pit just south of Little Birch Creek on Forest Service Lands. The reissued permit would authorize continued use of approximately 5.0 acres of land on the Spanish Fork Ranger District, in Township 12 South, Range 1 East, North east ¼ Sections 21 SLM.

The public is invited to provide comments on this proposal. Comments should be as specific as possible and have a direct relationship to the proposal.
