

**NOTICE OF DECISION**  
**USDA - Forest Service**  
**Uinta National Forest, Heber Ranger District**  
**Wasatch County, Utah**  
**Strawberry River Monitoring Wells**

The Heber Ranger District of the Uinta National Forest has completed an analysis of the Strawberry River water monitoring wells.

The Responsible Official, Heber Ranger District Ranger Julie King, approved the decision memo for the construction of this project. The Heber Ranger District, in coordination with Utah Reclamation, Mitigation, and Conservation Central Commission, will drill 9-15 temporary monitoring wells. The wells will be used to monitor groundwater levels in Strawberry Valley to determine groundwater-surface water interaction and viability of restoring stream flow to the existing channel. The monitoring wells will be located in Township 2 South, Range 12 West, Sections 9 and 15.

This legal notice provides notification of the final decision associated with this project. Pursuant to 36 CFR 2155.12(f) and *Earth Island Institute v. Ruthenbeck*, No. CIV F-03-386 JKS (E.D. Cal., October 19, 2005), this decision is not subject to appeal. Implementation may begin immediately.
