

## **REQUEST FOR COMMENTS**

Mapleton City Waterline

The Spanish Fork Ranger District of the Uinta National Forest is proposing to issue a special use permit for a 12" water line to Mapleton City. The water line would be located in Township 8 South, Range 3 East, section 24 (NE ¼, of the NE ¼ ) within the Old Fire break roadbed, during the fall/winter of 2007.

Mapleton City is planning to enhance their city water system by connecting their water well, in the south end of town, to their existing water system at the mouth of Maple canyon. The water line required to connect these two water sources is located off National Forest Service land except for approximately 300 feet. This 300 foot section of new water pipeline, is proposed to be constructed in the roadbed of the Old Fire break road, under the existing power lines owned by Rocky Mountain Power.

The public is invited to provide comments on this proposal. Comments should be as specific as possible and have a direct relationship to the proposal. Comments received or postmarked within 30 days of the date of publication of this legal notice in the *Provo Herald* will be considered. Please send written comments to: Douglas H.
