LOCAL FOREST TO HOST FEE FREE DAYS

PROVO, UTAH, September 19, 2008 – The Forest Service will host a Fee Free Day, in conjunction with National Public Lands Day, on Saturday, September 27. All day-use fees will be waived on this day, and Sunday, September 28.

Visitors recreating in Mill Creek Canyon, American Fork Canyon, the Alpine Loop, and Mirror Lake Scenic Byway on these two days will be exempt from the fee normally charged for these areas. Campground fees will remain the same.

National Public Lands Day encourages stewardship and visitation to lands managed by the Department of Interior and the Department of Agriculture through volunteer projects and fee free recreation opportunities.
