Higher mountain areas are wet, muddy or have patches of snow. Natural resources are very fragile when wet, so please be careful and only drive or camp on dry, solid surfaces. Off-highway vehicle users are responsible for knowing which roads and trails are open to motorized use. Travel Plan maps, which show what roads and trails are open to motorized vehicles, should be procured and are available at local Forest Service offices.

**Most campgrounds are open with drinking water, trash collection and fees. Jefferson Hunt has reopened but drinking water may not be available. Monte Cristo campground will be open this weekend, water system is being worked on, and reservations for the two group sites begin June 30.**

Limited dispersed (undeveloped site) camping is allowed in some areas, if parking is feasible, although **it is strongly discouraged due to the impact on soils when the ground is wet and muddy**. Dispersed camping around the South Fork campgrounds is never allowed. Campgrounds have fees, services, restrooms and other facilities available now that they are open. Please remember to **PACK OUT all trash** if services are not available.

### CAMPGROUND RESERVATIONS

Reservations for camping are being accepted on a “floating basis” for individual and group sites; *Single/Double* sites can be reserved for **Anderson Cove** and **South Fork** 6 months prior but not less than 5 days in advance. **Group** reservations **are required** and can be made for **Anderson Cove, Perception Park** and **Monte Cristo** campgrounds up to one year in advance. **SENIOR and ACCESS Interagency Passes are NOT valid for GROUP or DOUBLE sites; only SINGLE sites are covered. Camping is half price, but day-use (swimming, boat launch, picnic, etc.) is not included.** Make all camping reservations at web page [www.Recreation.gov](http://www.Recreation.gov) or call 1-877-444-6777. Phone calls may require extensive delays due to heavy use, but the web site is typically reliable. **Holiday weekends for all Anderson Cove reserve sites, and South Fork sites, are reserved now; cancellations may occur but are extremely unlikely!**

### ANDERSON COVE Beach “B”

Anderson Cove “Beach” is an extension of Anderson Cove campground, and has sites available for day-use and 10-tent camping sites. Picnic tables, restrooms and two group sites are available. **Cache** and **Trappers** group sites may be reserved through [www.Recreation.gov](http://www.Recreation.gov) or by calling 1-877-444-6777. The tent camping sites are available on a first-come, first-serve basis. The charge for overnight camping is \$12.

**Maples Campground** –The gate just off the pavement at the bottom parking lot is closed. The area is managed as **Day-Use** only with no permitted overnight camping. Access is permitted for walk-ins/bicycles/horses when **specifically authorized by the Ogden Ranger District**. The Ogden Ranger District has a yurt nearby but does not accept reservations. Use is restricted to two nights, occupants must share with other users, and no services are provided.

### PINEVIEW RESERVOIR

The Cemetery Point and Port Ramp boat launch facilities are open. Anderson Cove boat launch is open only to those who have paid for camping at Anderson Cove or the Anderson Cove Beach “B” area. ATV travel is not allowed adjacent to Pineview Reservoir.

Port Ramp is open all year, and in summer a host is on-site to collect fees. **Pineview Reservoir boat slips and Annual Boat Launch passes are managed by American Land & Leisure; call AL&L at Pineview Reservoir: 801-745-3215, 801-745-0950 or Provo office at 801-226-3564.**

**Higher elevation roads/trails are not accessible due to snow drifts and muddy conditions. Dry Bread area shows evidence of resource damage where campers have camped in muddy conditions.**

**East slope roads will likely have snow drifts. Old Canyon road and New Canyon road are open to the forest boundary. West slope roads are open, with intermittent snow drifts on top of North Curtis Creek. Baxter Sawmill road is open.**

**Eli Ridge and Baldy Ridge Roads have seasonal closures. They were locked on September 17 and will open again when muddy conditions do not exist.**

**Monte Cristo Highway 39 is open. Please stay off snow packed or muddy secondary roads and trails to avoid resource damage.** Be careful on roads and trails during inclement weather, and always be aware that weather conditions change very quickly in mountainous areas.

## TRAILHEADS

Trailheads that remain open all year include Art Nord - SR-226 Snowbasin Road (open through winter to Forest Boundary); Skullcrack; Pineview Trailhead to Skyline Trail parking lot (west side of Pineview south of Port Ramp); North Arm Wildlife Viewing Trail; Quist Beach on east side of Pineview Reservoir; and Pineview West from Pineview Trailhead to North Arm. Use the trails with care and be prepared for inclement weather.

**Rattlesnakes are being reported on the trails. Use caution.**
