The Trabuco Ranger District, Cleveland National Forest, purposes to restore and rehabilitate Blue Jay Campground by doing the following activities:

- Replace the existing toilet with sweet smelling toilets that are ADA, (American with Disabilities Act) accessible;
- 2-3 camp sites will be made ADA accessible;
- 3-4 sites will become mini group sites;
- 5 sites will be designated for use as either day use or overnight camp sites;
- 6-10 sites will be lengthened and level to make them accessible for motor homes of up to 45 feet;
- Parking spurs and the road through the campground will be paved;
- The Upper Trailhead for the San Juan Trail will be paved and striped;
- Electricity will be brought in for the host site at a minimum, may also be extended to other sites ;
- All electrical lines will be placed underground from Long Canyon;
- All potable water spigots will be upgraded;
- A two sided shower facility (4 shower heads on each side) with sinks will be added;
- Hot water for the shower facility will be provided by a solar water heating system;
- Hot water may also be provided by an electric water heating system or through the use of a propane gas tank;
- A facility to handle gray water from the shower facility would be installed. A vault system designed to hold the water until it can be pumped out by commercial



waste removers may be used; or, a septic system employing the use of a leach field may be used. This facility may also be used to upgrade the toilets, as well as provide a drain for campers gray water;

- If a septic system is used, it will meet the Orange County standard for installation and use;
- And, a new 3 paneled kiosk would be installed;

Blue Jay Campground is located approximately 4 miles north of Ortega Highway; approximately ½ mile west of North Main Dive Road on Long Canyon Road. The legal location is T6S, R5w, R6W, sections 13& 18, Orange County, California.
