

# Attention! Help protect your wildlife.

To protect nesting peregrine falcons, the Corte Madera area, as shown on the map below, is closed until July 31, 2009. This includes all climbing routes east of routes 1634 and 1630 shown on pages 154 and 155 of the San Diego County Climbing Guide (Kennedy and Hubbard, 2006), including "Cropduster" and "Log Jam," and all formations east of those routes except for Video Dome and El Nino. Note: Photo below shows climbing faces closed to activity. Actual closure includes downhill portions.




