

ORDER NO 02-09-02

CLEVELAND NATIONAL FOREST

EMERGENCY CLOSURE

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a), and to protect nesting Peregrine Falcons, the following act is prohibited within the Cleveland National Forest. This Order is effective from May 8, 2009, through July 31, 2009.

Going into or being upon the southeastern face of Corte Madera Mountain, as shown on attached map.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
