

**ORDER NUMBER 03-05-07**  
**\*MOTOR VEHICLE RESTRICTIONS\***  
**ELDORADO NATIONAL FOREST**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to protect natural resources, the following acts are prohibited within the Eldorado National Forest. This order is effective from August 25, 2005, through December 31, 2007.

1. Possessing or using a wheeled motor vehicle off National Forest System roads or trails, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.56.
2. Using a wheeled motor vehicle on National Forest System roads, except for the National Forest System roads shown as open on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.54(a).
3. Using a wheeled motor vehicle on National Forest System trails, except for the National Forest System trails shown as open on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.55(b).

For purposes of this Order, a wheelchair is not considered to be a wheeled motor vehicle.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions contained in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
