Location: 40 miles east of Jackson on Highway 88 then go south 2 1/2 miles on Bear River Road. At the “Y” intersection go west (right) across the dam. Travel 2 miles staying to the left. (See map on backside).

Activities/Facilities Within 5 Miles

- ◆ Swimming, Fishing, Picnicking.
- ◆ Bear River Resort: restaurant, store, boat launch, boat rentals, fishing licenses, dump station, showers.
- ◆ Emergency phone at Bear River Resort and Pardoes Point campground.
- ◆ Vehicles with an Off-Highway Vehicle license “green or red sticker” are not legal on campground roads. These vehicles must be trailered to staging areas and authorized routes.

Things You Should Know


- ◆ The campground is generally open between mid-June and early October. These dates are affected by snowfall. Call Sierra Recreation Managers (SRM) for site availability outside of the reservation window at (209) 295-4512.
- ◆ All food must be stored in the food lockers (Bear Boxes).
- ◆ The campground is at about 6,000’ elevation.
- ◆ Keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Please use the stove or fire ring provided and make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil.
- ◆ Park all vehicles in the parking lot. Vehicles may be driven to the camping area to load and unload only. For persons with special needs, a vehicle may be left at the campsite, with the host’s approval.
- ◆ Check out time is 1:00 p.m.






Location Map


