
- ◆ Swimming, Picnicking, Fishing
- ◆ Phone at campground entrance. (Phone card only.)
- ◆ Boating (no motors allowed at Kirkwood Lake, 5 m.p.h. limit on Caples Lake).
- ◆ Horseback riding: Kirkwood Corrals and Kirkwood Stables.
- ◆ Water-skiing (Silver Lake)
- ◆ Hiking access to Mokelumne Wilderness (permit required for overnight use year-round). Permits available at Carson Pass Information Station (summer only) and the Amador Ranger Station.
- ◆ Caples Lake Resort: restaurant, store, boat launch, boat rentals, fishing licenses, phone, cabin rentals.
- ◆ Kirkwood Ski Area: restaurant, store, post office, room rentals, gas, phone, fishing licenses, summer recreation program.
- ◆ EID Boat Launch. Public phone available.
- ◆ Kit Carson Lodge: boat rentals, cabin rentals, restaurant, store, laundromat, phone.

Things You Should Know

- ◆ **No Reservations.** Sites are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Campground Host on site.
- ◆ Interagency Senior and Access passes are accepted for single family units.
- ◆ The campground is generally open between June 15th and Oct. 15th. These dates are affected by snowfall.
- ◆ The campground is at about 7,600' elevation.
- ◆ Single units are limited to a maximum of 2 vehicles and 6 people. Double units are 4 vehicles and 12 people. Additional fee required for extra vehicles.
- ◆ Trailers are not recommended because of difficulty of getting trailers in and out of area.
- ◆ All food must be stored in the food lockers (Bear Boxes).
- ◆ Please keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Please use the stove or fire ring provided.
- ◆ Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.
- ◆ Make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Please use water only (not soil).
- ◆ Check out time is 1:00 p.m.


