
#### Things You Should Know

- ◆ **No Reservations.** Sites are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- ◆ The campground is generally open between May 1st and Nov. 15th. These dates are affected by snowfall.
- ◆ The campground is at about 5,600' elevation.
- ◆ Restroom cleaning is provided mid-May to mid-October. No garbage service, "Pack It In, Pack it Out".

- ◆ There is no piped water at the campground. Water from the river is available but should be boiled before using. Water quality testing is not performed on open water sources.
- ◆ Please keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.
- ◆ Make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Please use water only (not soil).

**Location Map**


