Things You Should Know

- ◆ **No Reservations.** Sites are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Campground Host on site.
- ◆ Parking fee at Day Use Area
- ◆ The campground is generally open between May 1st and November 15th. These dates are affected by snowfall.
- ◆ Interagency Senior and Access passes are accepted for single family units.


- ◆ The campground is at about 6,000' elevation.
- ◆ Sites are limited to a maximum of 2 vehicles and 6 people. Double sites are 4 vehicles and 12 people. Additional fee required for extra vehicles.
- ◆ Please check with the campground attendant or entrance board before setting up your camp.
- ◆ There is no piped water at the campground. Water from the lake is available but should be boiled before using. Water quality testing is not performed on open water sources.
- ◆ Vehicles with an Off-Highway Vehicle license "green or red sticker" are not legal on campground roads. These vehicles must be trailered to staging areas and authorized routes.
- ◆ Please keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Please use the stove or fire ring provided and make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil.
- ◆ Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.
- ◆ Check out time is 1:00 p.m.


