Activities/Facilities Within 5 Miles

- ◆ Swimming, Fishing, Public phone (Calling card only).
- ◆ Picnic Area (8 sites) near the campground on the river
- ◆ Wheelchair accessible trail and fishing piers.
- ◆ Vehicles with an Off-Highway Vehicle license “green or red sticker” are not legal on campground roads. These vehicles must be trailered to staging areas and authorized routes in the Gold Note and Elkins Flat trail areas.
- ◆ Cooks Station: restaurant, store, gas, public phone.

Things You Should Know

- ◆ The campground is generally open between May 1st and Nov. 15th. These dates are affected by snowfall.
- ◆ Campground Host on site.
- ◆ Interagency Senior and Access passes are accepted for single family units.
- ◆ The campground is at about 4,100' elevation.
- ◆ Single units are limited to a maximum of 2 vehicles and 6 people. Double units are 4 vehicles and 12 people. Triple units are 6 vehicles and 18 people. Additional fee required for extra vehicles.
- ◆ Please check with the campground attendant or entrance board before setting up your camp.
- ◆ Please keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Please use the stove or fire ring provided and make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil.
- ◆ Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.
- ◆ Check out time is 1:00 p.m.
