- ◆ Swimming, Fishing, Picnicking, Boating, Hiking, and Horseback riding (Kirkwood area).
- ◆ EID Boat Launch. Public phone available.
- ◆ Kit Carson Lodge: boat rentals, cabin rentals, restaurant, store, laundry, phone.
- ◆ Caples Lake Resort: restaurant, store, boat rentals, fishing licenses, phone, cabin rentals.
- ◆ Silver Lake West Campground (E.I.D.) 35 units.

- ◆ Kirkwood Ski Area: restaurant, store, post office, room rentals, gas, phone, fishing licenses.

Things You Should Know

- ◆ The campground is generally open between June 1st and Oct. 15th. These dates are affected by snowfall.
- ◆ Interagency Senior and Access passes are accepted for single family units.
- ◆ The campground is at about 7,200' elevation.
- ◆ Single units are limited to a maximum of 2 vehicles and 6 people. Double units are 4 vehicles and 12 people. Additional fee required for extra vehicles.
- ◆ Please check with the campground attendant or entrance board before setting up your camp.
- ◆ All food must be stored in the food lockers when available (Bear Boxes).
- ◆ Please keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Please use the stove or fire ring provided and make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil.
- ◆ Check out time is 1:00 p.m.

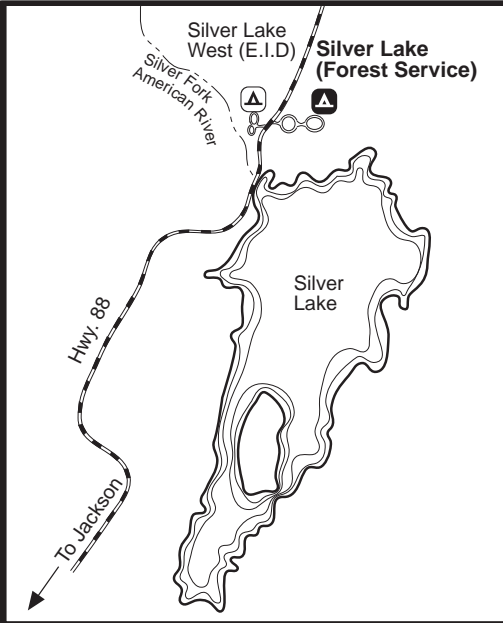

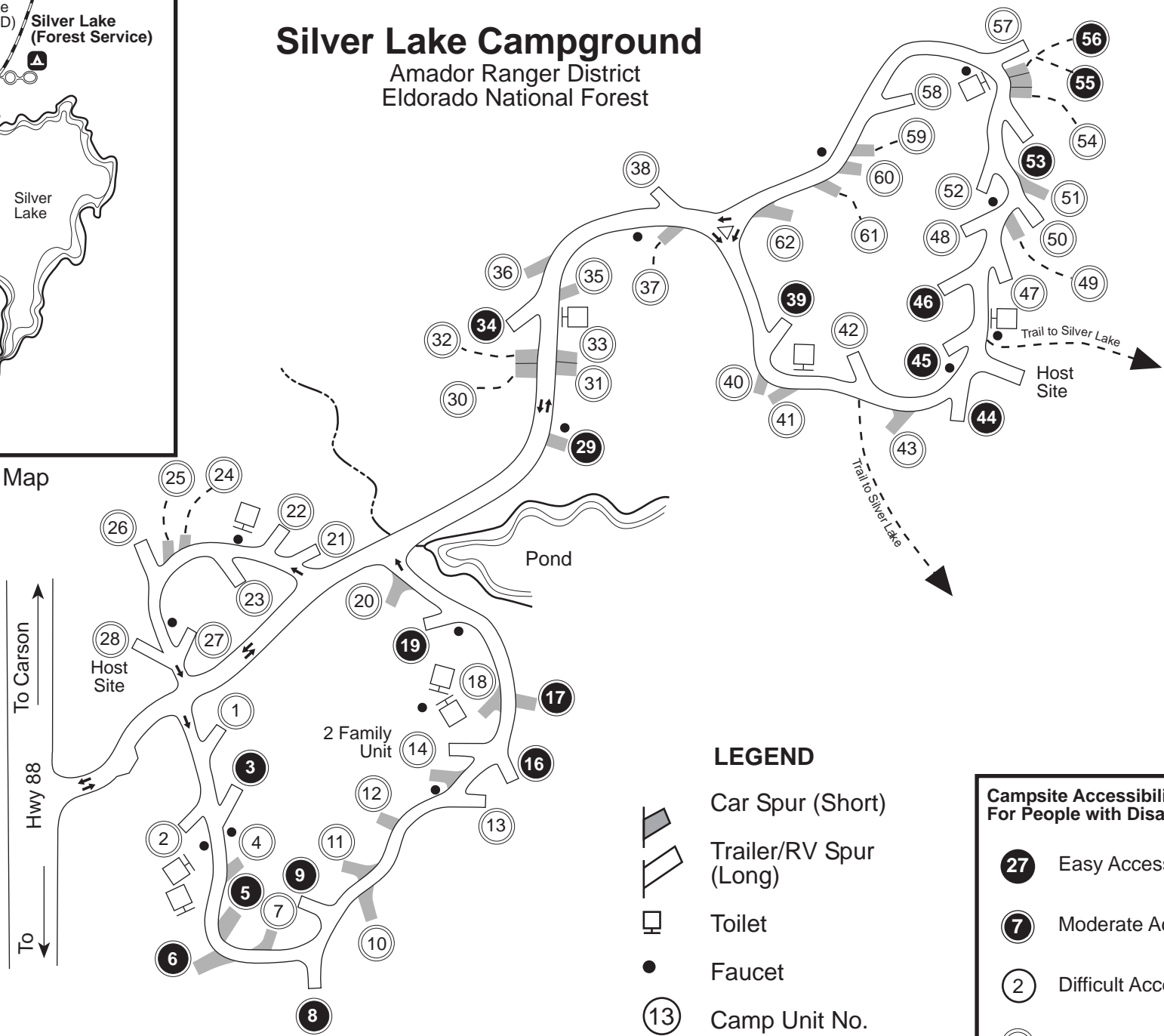
