### Things You Should Know


- ◆ In units 1, 3, & 4, all vehicles must be kept in the unit's central parking area. No trailers are allowed because of the difficulty of getting trailers in and out of these areas.
- ◆ The campground is generally open between April 15th and Oct. 15th. These dates are affected by snowfall.
- ◆ The campground is at about 4,400' elevation.
- ◆ Please keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Please use the stove or fire ring provided and make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil.
- ◆ Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.
- ◆ Other fees: Dump = \$6.00, Pet = \$2.00
- ◆ Check out time is 1:00 p.m.


