### Activities/Facilities Within 5 Miles


- ◆ Swimming and Fishing. Picnic Area at Stumpy Meadows Boat Ramp.
- ◆ Boat Ramp/Boarding Dock at Stumpy Meadows Reservoir (no water-skiing is allowed, 5 m.p.h. speed limit).
- ◆ Dump station is located next to the Ponderosa Cove overflow campground.

### Things You Should Know

- ◆ The campground is generally open between April 15th and Nov. 1st. These dates are affected by snowfall.
- ◆ Interagency Senior and Access passes are accepted for single family units.
- ◆ The campground is at about 4,400' elevation.
- ◆ Sites are limited to a maximum of 2 vehicles and 6 people.
- ◆ Please check with the campground attendant or entrance board before setting up your camp.
- ◆ Please keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Please use the stove or fire ring provided and make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil.
- ◆ Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.
- ◆ Other fees: Dump = \$6.00, Pet = \$2.00
- ◆ Check out time is 1:00 p.m.




**Location Map**
