
Things You Should Know

- ◆ The campground is generally open between Memorial Day weekend and mid-October. These dates are affected by snow conditions.
- ◆ The campground is at about 4,900' elevation.
- ◆ There is no piped water available at the campground. Stream water is available close by but should be boiled before using. Water quality testing is not performed on open water sources. Piped water is available at Sunset Boat Ramp.
- ◆ Keep your vehicles on the pavement.
- ◆ Riding OHV's in campground is not allowed.
- ◆ Please use the stove or fire ring provided.
- ◆ Make sure your fire is dead out before leaving.
- ◆ Please keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Keep the gate closed or visitors will wander in. Gate combination will be issued when reservations are finalized.
- ◆ Check out time is 1:00 p.m.
