- ◆ CALL 1-877-444-6777, four days to six months in advance of your first night's stay.
- ◆ WEBSITE: www.Recreation.gov
- ◆ Visa, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover.
- ◆ Interagency Senior and Access passes are accepted for single family units. Give your pass number when making a reservation.
- ◆ Some sites are available through reservation. All other sites are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Activities/Facilities Within 5 Miles

- ◆ Swimming, Fishing, Hiking, Boat Ramp/Loading Dock
- ◆ Picnic Area (5 Sites) at facility
- ◆ Hiking in Desolation Wilderness (permits required for **both day use and overnight** use. Overnight permits are only available at the Pacific Ranger Station on Highway 50, 4 miles east of Pollock Pines). Day use permits area available at the Loon Lake trailhead in the summer and Pacific Ranger Station year-round.

Things You Should Know


- ◆ The campground is generally open between mid-June and mid-October. These dates are affected by snow conditions.
- ◆ The campground is at about 6,500' elevation.
- ◆ Single units are limited to 2 vehicles and 6 people per site. Double units are 4 vehicles and 12 people. An additional fee will be charged for an extra vehicle if the parking spur will accommodate it.
- ◆ Vehicle = Any equipment that is required to be licensed/registered. Includes RVs, trailers, cars/trucks, boat/car trailer, motorcycle/atv, etc. Vehicles parked in a truck or on a trailer are not counted separately.
- ◆ Please check with the campground attendant or entrance board before setting up your camp.
- ◆ All food must be stored in the food lockers (Bear Boxes).
- ◆ Keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Check out time is 1:00 p.m.






