



# Pleasant Campground

## Eldorado National Forest



District: Pacific Ranger District

Location: 23 miles east of Placerville on Highway 50 and 29 miles north on Forest Ice House Road (Forest Road 3), and 4 miles east by foot trail or 3 miles by boat access across Loon Lake. (See map on backside).

- ◆ Hiking in Desolation Wilderness (**permits required for both day use and overnight use. Overnight permits are only available at the Pacific Ranger Station on Highway 50, 4 miles east of Pollock Pines (north side of highway).** Day use permits are available at the Loon Lake trailhead in the summer and at the Pacific Ranger Station year-round.

#### Things You Should Know

- ◆ **No Reservations.** Sites are available on a first-come, first-served basis,
- ◆ The campground is only accessible by boat or trail.
- ◆ The campground is generally open between mid-June and mid-October. These dates are affected by snow conditions.
- ◆ The campground is at about 6,400' elevation.
- ◆ There is no piped water available at the campground. Lake and stream water are available close by but should be boiled before using. Water quality testing is not performed on open water sources.
- ◆ Please use the stove or fire ring provided.
- ◆ Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.
- ◆ Make sure your fire is dead out before leaving
- ◆ Please bury your waste or pack it out.
- ◆ No campfires during fire restrictions.
- ◆ No garbage service. Pack It In, Pack It Out.

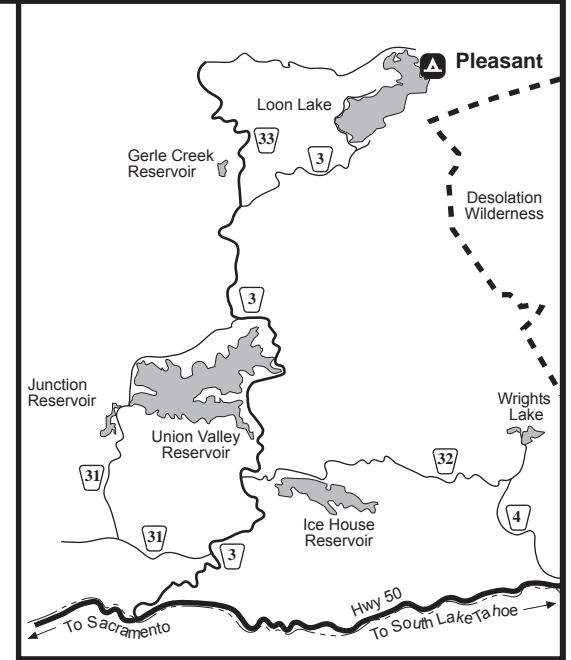

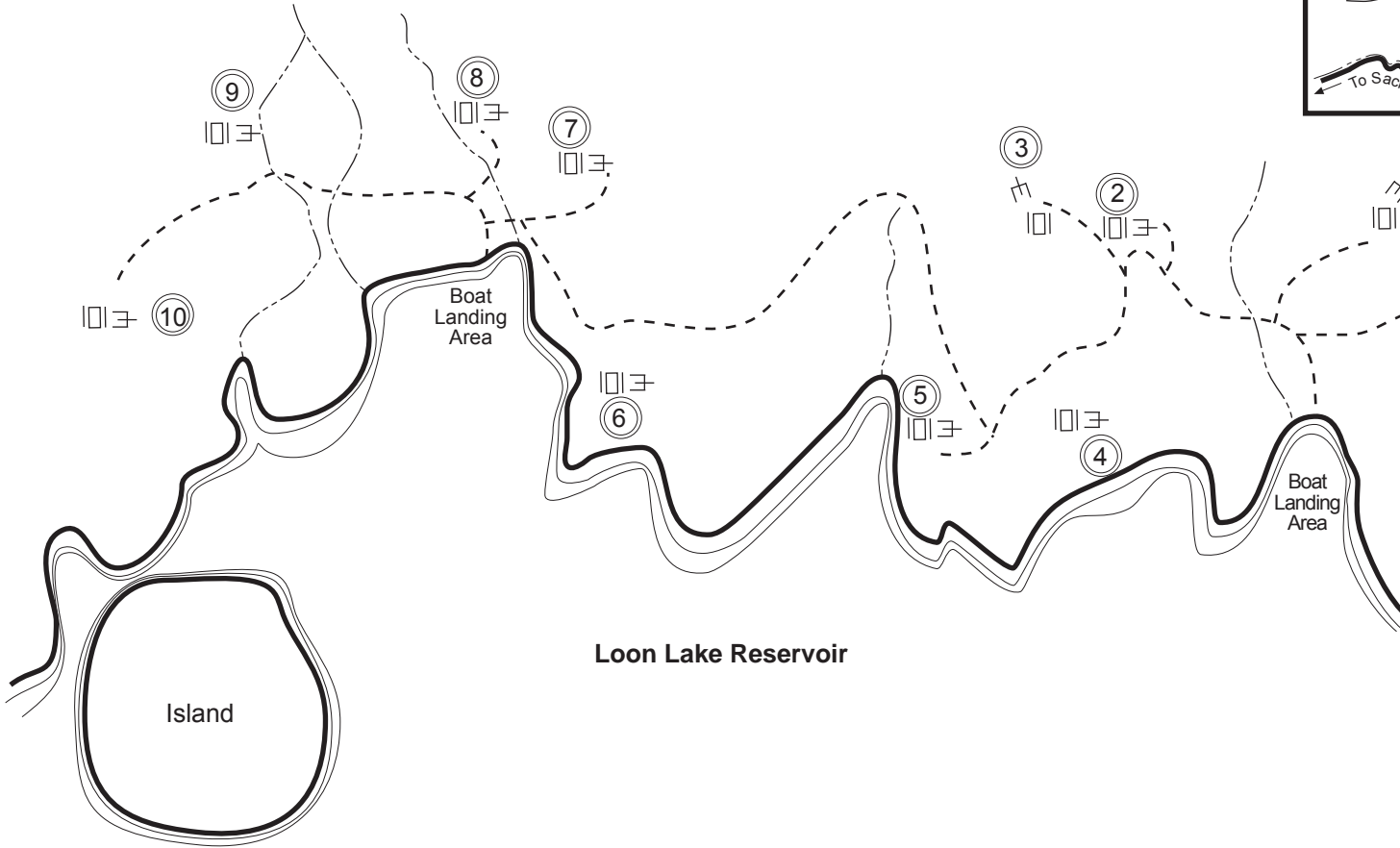
