Things You Should Know

- ◆ The campground is generally open between Memorial Day Weekend to late-September. These dates are affected by snow conditions.
- ◆ The campground is at about 5,200' elevation.
- ◆ There is no piped water available at the campground. Stream water is available close by but should be boiled before using. Water quality testing is not performed on open water sources.
- ◆ Note: parking space is limited 6-7 vehicles. Trailers are not recommended due to narrow road and tight turns.
- ◆ Please use the stove or fire ring provided.
- ◆ Keep the gate closed or visitors will wander in.
- ◆ Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.
- ◆ Make sure your fire is dead out before leaving.
- ◆ Please keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Check out time is 1:00 p.m.





