- ◆ The campground is at 5,200' elevation.


- ◆ The campground is generally open between mid-June and early November. These dates are affected by snow conditions.
- ◆ There is no piped water at the campground. Water from the stream is available but should be boiled before using. Water quality testing is not performed on open water sources.
- ◆ Please use the stove or fire ring provided.
- ◆ Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.
- ◆ Make sure your fire is dead out before leaving.
- ◆ Keep the gate closed or visitors may wander in. Gate combination will be issued when reservations are finalized.
- ◆ Please leash your pets.
- ◆ Riding OHV's in the campground is not allowed.
- ◆ Check out time is 1:00 p.m.




**Location Map**
