
Things You Should Know

- ◆ **No Reservations.** Sites are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- ◆ The campground is generally open between Memorial Day Weekend and late September. These dates are affected by snow conditions.
- ◆ Interagency Senior and Access passes are accepted for single family units.



- ◆ The campground is at about 4,900' elevation.
- ◆ Single units are limited to 2 vehicles and 6 people per site. An additional fee will be charged for an extra vehicle if the parking spur will accommodate it.
- ◆ Vehicle = Any equipment that is required to be licensed/registered. Includes RVs, trailers, cars/trucks, boat/car trailer, motorcycle/atv, etc. Vehicles parked in a truck or on a trailer are not counted separately.
- ◆ Please check with the campground attendant or entrance board before setting up your camp.
- ◆ Please keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Please use the stove or fire ring provided.
- ◆ Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.
- ◆ Make sure your fire is dead out before leaving.
- ◆ Check out time is 1:00 p.m.
