

### Things You Should Know

- ◆ The campground is generally open between Memorial Day Weekend to late September. These dates are affected by snow conditions.
- ◆ The campground is at about 4,900 feet elevation.
- ◆ Please keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Please use the stove or fire ring provided.
- ◆ Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.
- ◆ Make sure your fire is dead out before leaving.
- ◆ Union Valley Bike Trail is a 5 mile long paved accessible bike trail from Jones Fork Campground to Tells Creek along the east side of the Reservoir.
- ◆ Check out time is 1:00 p.m.


