



# Wrights Lake Campground

## Eldorado National Forest



**District:** Pacific Ranger District

**Location:** 23 miles east of Placerville on Highway 50, 11 miles north on Ice House Road (Forest Road 3), 9 miles east on Forest Road 32 (Wrights Lake Tie Road), and 2 miles north on Forest Road 4 (Wrights Lake Rd).

- ◆ Give your Interagency Senior or Access number when making a reservation. (accepted for single family units only).
- ◆ Reservations are required from the Friday after the 4th of July through Labor Day Monday.
- ◆ Unit #37 may be reserved by campground residents for group potlucks. Contact the ranger at the campground or call the Ranger District at 530-647-5415.

### Activities/Facilities Within 5 Miles

- ◆ Swimming, Fishing, Hiking
- ◆ Picnic Area (10 sites all accessible) at facility
- ◆ Equestrian Campground (15 sites)
- ◆ Boating - no motors (gas or electric) allowed.

- ◆ Hiking in Desolation Wilderness (permits are required for day-use and in advance for overnight use. Overnight permits are only available at the Pacific Ranger District, 4 miles east of Pollock Pines on Highway 50. Day permits are available at the trailhead in the summer and at Pacific RD year-round.

### Things You Should Know

- ◆ The campground is generally open between late June and mid-October. These dates are affected by snow conditions.
- ◆ The campground is at about 7,000' elevation.
- ◆ Single units are limited to 2 vehicles and 6 people per site. Double units are 4 vehicles and 12 people. An additional fee will be charged for an extra vehicle if the parking spur will accommodate it.
- ◆ Vehicle = Any equipment that is required to be licensed/registered. Includes RVs, trailers, cars/trucks, boat/car trailer, motorcycle/atv, etc. Vehicles parked in a truck or on a trailer are not counted.
- ◆ Keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Check out time is 1:00 p.m.


