- ◆ CALL 1-877-444-6777, seven to 180 days in advance of your first night's stay.
- ◆ WEBSITE: www.Recreation.gov
- ◆ Visa, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover accepted.
- ◆ Give your Interagency Senior or Access number when making a reservation (accepted for single family units).
- ◆ Some sites are available through reservation. The remainder are on a first-come, first-served basis.

Activities/Facilities Within 5 Miles

- ◆ Swimming and Fishing
- ◆ Picnic Area (10 sites all accessible) at facility
- ◆ Boat loading dock at facility
- ◆ Boating - no motors (gas or electric) allowed
- ◆ Hiking and horseback riding in Desolation Wilderness (permits required for both day use and

overnight use. Overnight permits are only available at the Pacific Ranger Station on Highway 50, 4 miles east of Pollock Pines). Day use permits area available at the trailheads (summer only).

Things You Should Know


- ◆ The campground is generally open between mid-June and mid-October. These dates are affected by snow conditions.
- ◆ The campground is at about 7,000' elevation.
- ◆ Equestrian units are limited to 4 vehicles (including horse trailers) and 6 people per site. An additional fee will be charged for an extra vehicle if the parking spur will accommodate it.
- ◆ Vehicle = Any equipment that is required to be licensed/registered. Includes RVs, trailers, cars/trucks, boat/car trailer, motorcycle/atv, etc. Vehicles parked in a truck or on a trailer are not counted separately.
- ◆ Check out time is 1:00 p.m.


