

- ◆ If the campground is **not signed as reserved** then the sites are available for individual family camping on a first-come first-served basis.
- ◆ The campground is generally open between Memorial Day and Labor Day weekends. These dates are affected by snowfall.
- ◆ The campground is at about 5,200' elevation.
- ◆ Sites are limited to a maximum of 2 vehicles and 6 people.
- ◆ Please keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Please use the stove or fire ring provided and make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil. Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.
- ◆ Check out time is 1:00 p.m.


