
Things You Should Know

- ◆ **No Reservations.** Sites are available on a first-come, first-served basis. There is now an overnight camping fee and a fee for extra vehicles.
- ◆ Interagency Senior and Access passes are accepted for single family units.
- ◆ **CAUTION:** There are bears in the area. Please keep all foods, soaps, and garbage contained.
- ◆ The campground is generally open between May 15th and Nov 1st. These dates are affected by snowfall.
- ◆ The campground is at about 5,800' elevation.
- ◆ Overnight parking spaces are designated by a numbered post which corresponds to camp unit numbers.
- ◆ Day use parking is available. (See map on back side).

- ◆ Parking spaces are limited. Please do not park on private property.
- ◆ Please keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Please use the stove or fire ring provided and make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil.
- ◆ Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.
- ◆ Check out time is 1:00 p.m.


