



**Dutch Creek Fuel Reduction and Road Improvement Phase 1
Klamath National Forest
Siskiyou County
2004**

Project Description:

The Klamath River Fire Safe Council and the Klamath National Forest are working cooperatively on the Dutch Creek Fuel Reduction and Road Improvement Project. Dutch Creek has four full-time residences, and except in years of extreme drought, water runs year round and provides fish habitat and steelhead spawning grounds. It is also designated as a deer wintering area and supports deer populations of the Siskiyou Mountain Range.

The project goals and objective are to improve public and firefighter safety by reducing hazardous fuels and providing better access along the Dutch Creek Road. The work includes hand and mechanical treatments by local volunteers, local contract crews and Klamath National Forest crews and is expected to be completed by early December.
