Juanita Lake campground on Goosenest Ranger District to be closed due to road construction

The Juanita Lake recreational area on the Goosenest Ranger District of the Klamath National Forest will be closed beginning May 15, 2009 for road construction and camping spur alignment. It is expected that the work may be completed by July 1, 2009.

Project work will include road paving and leveling spurs for camping. The campground, group camping, and day use areas will be closed during this time, however, access to the lake for fishing will not be closed by this project work. Those who want to fish may park off-road below the dam, or off the north access road.

The Juanita Lake recreation area is one of the most popular sites on the Goosenest Ranger District. Some camping sites and picnic tables there are accessible for persons with disabilities, as is the trail around the lake. It is located off U.S. Highway 97 approximately seven miles southwest of Macdoel, CA.
