Klamath National Forest rebuilds horse corrals at Lovers' Camp

The Salmon/Scott River Ranger District of the Klamath National Forest has begun to replace the horse corrals at the Lovers' Camp trailhead. According to district personnel, the split rail corrals currently in service there are no longer functional. They are being replaced with steel corrals.

Work is expected to be completed by July 1, 2009. This project will not restrict access to the water supply for stock.
