

Fire Restrictions Are In Effect

Due to extreme fire danger in Los Padres National Forest, and to protect public safety and forest resources, the following restrictions are in effect until further notice:

- ✿ **Discharging of firearms is prohibited in all areas of the national forest except at the Winchester Gun Club (in Santa Barbara County) and the Ojai Valley Gun Club (in Ventura County). This restriction does not prohibit the discharge of BB-guns or air rifles. This restriction does not prohibit hunting. Hunting is permitted with a valid California hunting license.**
- ✿ **Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, including wood or charcoal, is prohibited except at designated Campfire Use Sites as listed in Exhibit A. Portable lanterns or stoves using gas, jellied petroleum, or pressurized liquid fuel may be used outside of the listed Campfire Use Sites, but only with a valid California Campfire Permit. Campfire Permits are available free of charge from any Forest Service Office.**
- ✿ **Smoking is restricted to enclosed vehicles, buildings and designated Campfire Use Sites as listed in Exhibit A.**
- ✿ **Internal or external combustion engines must have a properly installed and maintained spark arrester in effective working order. (This restriction is in effect year-round.)**
- ✿ **Possessing, discharging or using any kind of firework or other pyrotechnic device is prohibited at all times in the national forest.**

By Forest Order 04-11-5100-03, signed by the Forest Supervisor on **September 1, 2004**, a violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individual \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. If you cause a wildfire, you could be held responsible for all fire suppression costs. For further information, contact your local ranger station.
