

MENDOCINO NATIONAL FOREST NOTICE OF DECISION

Proposal Name: Long Ridge OHV Corridor Connector

On December 5, 2007, Upper Lake District Ranger Lee Johnson signed a decision notice to revise the current road management objective for forest road 17N16. Total length of 17N16 is about 5.5 miles. The road management objective has been to provide for low clearance vehicles; the revised objective would be to provide for high clearance vehicles. The road is located in northeastern Lake County, California, about half-way between the Upper Lake and Stonyford OHV management areas.
