Cedar Pass and Mill Creek Campgrounds Hazard Tree Abatement

Warner Mountain Ranger District

The Warner Mountain District Ranger made the decision to implement the Cedar Pass and Mill Creek Campgrounds Hazard Tree Abatement Project. The Project is located in Modoc County, California, T43N R14E, Sec. 13 for the Cedar Pass Campground and T39N R15E, Sec. 29 for the Mill Creek Campground.

This project was categorically excluded from documentation in an Environmental Assessment (EA) or Environmental Impact statement (EIS) because it was found to be a minor action that meets the criteria for proposals that are known to have no significant environmental effects. Categories of actions that meet this criterion are described in detail in Forest Service Handbook 1909.15, Chapter 30.

The Forest Service received no written or oral comments in response to public scoping and request for comment, conducted by Legal Notice in the Modoc Record on May 25, 2006.

This project to remove approximately 200 dead and dying trees of various sizes from the Cedar Pass and Mill Creek campgrounds will enhance visitor safety and forest health and may be implemented immediately.
