

**ORDER NO. 07-06**  
**PLUMAS NATIONAL FOREST**  
**ROAD, TRAIL AND AREA CLOSURE**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the Zone X6a Vehicle Closure Area within the Plumas National Forest. This Closure Area is bounded by Diamond Mountain on the north, then southeast to the boundary of the Lassen National Forest, then south to the south end of Wildcat Ridge, then northwest to Indian Creek, then continuing northwest along Indian Creek to Red Rock, then northeast to the starting point at Diamond Mountain, as shown on the attached map. For the purposes of this order, a wheelchair is not considered a motor vehicle. This order is effective from October 4, 2006, through October 22, 2006.

1. Using a motor vehicle off National Forest system roads or trails within the Zone X6a Vehicle Closure Area. 36 CFR 261.56.
2. Using a motor vehicle on a National Forest system roads within the Zone X6a Vehicle Closure Area. 36 CFR 261.54(a).
3. Using a motor vehicle on a National Forest System trails within the Zone X6a Vehicle Closure Area. 36 CFR 261.55(b).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
