September 12 and 13 Monitoring Tours Postponed

QUINCY, CA – Due to the Moonlight Fire on the Plumas National Forest, the Herger-Feinstein Quincy Library Group (HFQLG) Pilot Project Area monitoring field tours scheduled for Wednesday, September 12 and Thursday, September 13 on the Beckwourth and Mt. Hough Ranger Districts have been postponed.

Both tours will be rescheduled for later this fall when the fire situation has improved.

The monitoring tours scheduled for the Lassen National Forest are still Thursday, October 4 on the Eagle Lake Ranger District and Wednesday, October 10 on the Almanor Ranger District.

These field trips will look at a variety of forest treatment projects ranging from thinning and fuels reduction to riparian restoration. The Pilot Project Area includes the Lassen and Plumas National Forests and the Sierraville Ranger District of the Tahoe National Forest.

The tours provide a chance to get an overview of the variety of projects being applied in the National Forests. Forest Service employees will also be gathering feedback during these trips from the public and other government agencies about how to improve future project management.

Many of the field trips will take a full day and participants should bring water and lunch. The terrain varies from district to district. Participants should dress appropriately.
