### **Diamond Mountain Motor Vehicle Restriction**

For the 24th consecutive year, selected roads in the Diamond Mountain area will be closed to motorized vehicles before and during deer hunting season within Zone X-6A. This motor vehicle restriction is due to the volume of vehicles in deer hunting areas during the deer season. The motor vehicle restriction goes into effect October 3, and continues through October 21, 2007. Closed forest roads include: 28N02, 28N02E, 28N35, 28N26X, 28N31, 28N02, 28N15, and 28N52. Motorized vehicles are prohibited both on and off roads and trails in the area.

Partners in this successful effort include the Plumas County Fish & Game Commission, California Department of Fish & Game, and the Plumas National Forest.

This is also a reminder that the Moonlight Fire closure has been lifted effective September 28. However, visitors traveling in the area are advised to use caution due to restoration efforts and the use of heavy equipment.

Some activities are exempt from this order including persons with disabilities using assistive devices such as wheelchairs.
