Slate Creek Bridge Closure

The Slate Creek Bridge will be closed for approximately two weeks beginning October 22-26 and October 28-31, to construct a new bridge deck. The bridge on Forest Service Road 24N28, is located about 0.6 mi off Plumas County Road 411 (Meadow Valley Road). Forest officials had hoped to complete the work during the summer, however, the work was delayed. Deanes Valley and the Rock Creek area may be accessed from Forest Service Road 24N29, which connects to Meadow Valley Road near Lowell Bader Park in Meadow Valley, or from Forest Service Road 24N20 from Quincy.
