### Residential Burning Suspended

As a result of fire weather predictions for our area, the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL-FIRE) has temporarily suspended all residential burning on private land in Plumas County under the fire protection of the Plumas National Forest, effective October 23. In other words, if residents obtain their burn permit from the Plumas National Forest, this applies.

There has also been a significant drawdown of firefighting resources and personnel due to the numerous severe fire incidents in southern California. All dooryard burning is suspended until further notice.
