Two Autumn Monitoring Tours Scheduled

QUINCY, CA – There are two remaining monitoring tours scheduled this month across the Herger-Feinstein Quincy Library Group (HFQLG) Pilot Project Area to review and offer input on forest management.

The field trip on the Almanor Ranger District of the Lassen National Forest has been rescheduled for Tuesday, October 16 and will visit the Deer Creek Watershed Riparian Restoration Project.

The Mt. Hough Ranger District field trip on the Plumas National Forest, which was cancelled during the Moonlight Fire, has been rescheduled for Monday, October 29. The tour will visit the Hungry and North Antelope Defensible Fuel Profile Zones (DFPZs).

These field trips will look at a variety of forest treatment projects ranging from thinning and fuels reduction to riparian restoration. The Pilot Project Area includes the Lassen and Plumas National Forests and the Sierraville Ranger District of the Tahoe National Forest.

The tours provide a chance to get an overview of the variety of projects being applied in the National Forests. Forest Service employees will also be gathering feedback during these trips from the public and other government agencies about how to improve future project management.

Many of the field trips will take a full day and participants should plan on bringing water and lunch. The terrain varies from district to district and autumn weather can change rapidly. Participants should be prepared for changing conditions.
