Temporary Road Closure at Long Valley Creek & Road 23N12

Plumas National Forest Road 23N12 will be temporarily closed north of its intersection with 23N11 (at Long Valley Creek) to allow construction of fish passage improvements. The closure will be in place for approximately 3 weeks from October 20 through November 7, 2008.

Alternate routes are available. Travelers can detour around the construction site via 23N12 to 23N12E (Bull Run Creek Road) to the west or 23N11 to 24N97 to the east. Detour signs will be posted at affected roads and intersections.



From October 20, 2008 through November 7, 2008 Road 23N12 will be temporarily closed to through traffic North of the intersection of 23N12 and 23N11 (at Long Valley Creek) to allow construction of fish passage improvements.
