## **Scales Road Closure**

Forest Service (FS) Road 20N35, known locally as the Scales Road, will be closed indefinitely for repairs due to a 200 foot landslide. Passenger vehicles may access the Scales area via Yuba Co. Road 2 near North Star to FS Road 20N63, through Buckeye Creek Area, Stowman Ravine, Simon Ravine, then to Sierra Co. Road 690.

The road closure is located about 1 1/2 miles southeast of Strawberry Guard Station. Closure begins at the junction of FS roads 20N35 and 20N04 (Frosty Hollow), and continues northeast to the junction of FS roads 20N35 and 21N11. The slide is in legal location T20N, R8E, Section 22, in the northeast corner. There is no estimated date of re-opening.
